


PASTOR'S CORNER

DR. WALLACE MCABEE,
SENIOR PASTOR

My beach book this summer was Hillbilly Elegy by JD Vance. The book is a life review of the author growing up in the extreme poverty and hopelessness rampant in Appalachia and much of working class America. JD chronicles the cultural meltdown of an entire people group that has been the backbone of our national success and strength for generations. While you may not be surprised by the stories of drug and alcohol abuse, government handouts, families falling apart and under employment – you might be surprised by one of his suggested ways forward. He reminds readers that people of this region are strong and have a proud heritage of accomplishment but are moving backward for the first time since Scotch/Irish immigrants first settled there. How do they overcome the lack of opportunity, the lack of ambition, the drug and family abuse and poor health care? The church – yes, the church – caught me off guard as well. Although he does not appear to be a churchman himself, he points out that the healthy marriages, the functional families, the working folks; the people with drive and a desire to help others are the people that actually go to church often! He mentions that as a region the people share a kind of Christian faith that is a bit more folklore than biblically sound. He also notes that most of the area is in the famed

Bible belt but that actual church attendance is one of the lowest in the nation. The ones that have their act together are the church people. The church is where working people learn about raising children, the value of a good education, loving their spouse, helping their neighbors, caring for their bodies and each other. Guess what, the same is true right here in East Coweta County. Active participation in a local church family leads to longer lives, healthier homes, happier and better adjusted people. So, why are so many "Believers" checked out and lying on the couch each Sunday? Good question. Most of you are incredible about your participation – while others not so much. So, for the best life imaginable make church life – yours!






The Pregnancy Care Ministry Team

This fundraiser is for the needed kitchen upgrades. We will have a jar in the foyer for you to place your loose coins.




