

# NOVEMBER NEWS

We asked, and you delivered!! Thank you so much for the generous donations to help purchase crayons for the children who became victims of Hurricane Florence in North Carolina. Assisting a Southern Baptist Disaster Relief Team deployed to North Carolina, the Adults on Mission Craft Group agreed to send everything we had on hand to those who had lost everything. Our prayer was that the scripture attached to each item would make the gospel known, and provide hope in a desperate time. We donated 274 bears, 220 bracelets, and 2,077 crosses bearing scripture in English and Spanish. Bible story leaflets were purchased for the children to color, and you all donated \$313 to purchase crayons!!!

The Disaster Relief Team we were coordinating with had been working for days, and had gone home for a few days to rest. Just as they were to head back to North Carolina, Hurricane Michael hit, and the team was immediately deployed to Florida. With our permission, they shared some of our donations with another Disaster Relief Team, and carried the remainder to Florida. Because of the two hurricanes, our efforts reached a larger geographical region than we originally anticipated, and through it all, YOU WERE THERE AS MISSIONARIES WHEN SALVATION, HOPE AND COMPASSION WERE DELIVERED. THANK YOU SHARPSBURG BAPTIST!!!

Hi, All-


