

### It's Christmas!

"Hark, the Herald Angels Sing" is a favorite Christmas carol. It tells us to listen to the wonderful news that Jesus was born. Did the angels really sing? The Bible doesn't really say that they did, but it seems that such wonderful news would have to include music! The hymn's words were written by Charles Wesley, a Methodist, who wrote over 6,000 hymns. Wesley hoped that his hymns would help teach Christianity to those who were unable to read the Bible. Wesley was inspired to write this hymn while walking to church on Christmas Day and hearing the church bells ringing. His original last line was "Glory to the King of Kings" but was changed later to what we know today: "Glory to the newborn King." One of our favorite songs in our Christmas musical says, "It's Christmas! The angels are singing, and I know the reason—the Savior is born!" That's the message of Christmas, right?

Our *Praise Ringers* have several pieces ready for the season, and our kids, under the direction of Jana Blackshire, are hard at work learning their parts for the musical. They will be a great addition to our program!

Our choir social is December 2<sup>nd</sup>, at 5:00, at our house. We'll have a great time eating, singing, and exchanging ornaments. It makes the season special for Jill and me.
