

Details of trip:

Saturday, June 2— leave church at 7:30am. It is approximately 400 miles, we will be stopping for lunch and getting fuel. We should get there approx 3pm CST. After getting settled in we will be leaving approximately 4:30pm for Job Corp Ministry. We will be eating dinner after.

<u>Sunday, June 3</u>– Some will be doing Job Corp Ministry, Some Camp Ground Service and some will be doing Church Services. In the evening, we will all be doing different church services.

Monday, June 4- We will be working on Joseph Bin Storage Ministry, Prison Ministry, and/or light contruction work. In the evening, Job Corp Ministry.
